# Why Does God Allow Wars to Take Place, and Diseases to Propagate?

## **Abstract**

#### 1. Introduction

A short review of history shows that there have been many wars (between tribes or nations), and many diseases through which many people were killed, injured and suffered for life.

Many people who believe in God, that He has created the Universe, and is managing all the affairs of the world according to His Order of the Universe, often ask the question: Why does He allow such events to take place? People state that they believe that God loves His creation: people and all other beings. They ask why then does He allow the suffering of people, animals and the entire environment?

We first give some information (found through a Google search) on the approximate number of people killed or injured through diseases and wars, and then make an attempt to provide an answer to the above question (employing the Hypotheses of the University of Life and Happiness).

# 2. People killed by diseases and through wars.

**Diseases**. It is estimated that **Plague** has caused the death of more than 200 million people, **Smallpox** has caused the death of more than 50 million people, **Influenza** the death of more than 50 million people, **HIV** the death of more than 35 million people, **Corona** the death of more than 6 million people and **Cholera** the death of more than 2 million people throughout the world.

**Wars**. There have been many wars through which many people have been killed. I mention a few of them here.

It is estimated that 38 to 60 million people were killed by the Moghol invasion of Iran and other countries, around 17 million people were killed by Teymoorlang invasion of Iran and other countries. During World War One, 15 to 22 million people were killed directly due to the war and 23 million people died due to famine, extreme cold and other causes due to war. During World War Two 52 to 60 million people were killed directly due to the war and 20 to 28 million more people died because of the lack of food, heat, shelter and other causes. (More people have been killed by this war than any other war in history).

The two atomic bombs dropped in Japan by US caused the death of 130,000 to 325,000 people and the injury of 95,000 more people. During the Vietnamese War

about 50,000 Americans were killed and more than 3 million Vietnamese were killed or severely injured.

### 3. The Order of the Universe

Scientists estimate that the physical world came into existence 13.5 to 15 billion years ago.

I believe before that there was only God and nothing else. God decided to create the universe and all that there are in it. He then devised an order, we call **the Order of the Universe.** 

Scientists now estimate that there are 2 trillion galaxies, including our own Milky Way Galaxy, there are 200 billion suns in our galaxy, including our own sun, and there are 8 planets and 146 moons and numerous comets and other objects, in our solar system. They estimate that there are  $10^{-24}$  (one Septillion) stars in the universe. The diameter of a hypothetical sphere containing all galaxies, is about 93 billion light years, or  $8.8*10^{-26}$  m.

Scientists estimate that planet earth came into being about 5 billion years ago, the first life started on earth about 2 billion years ago, the first human started to walk on earth (somewhere in East-Northeast Africa) about 2 million years ago, and the first human settlement, along with agriculture, started about 12,000 years ago (somewhere in the Middle East, a warm region between the present-day Iran and Iraq).

All these, including the creation of human beings, with all his/her capabilities and limitations, have been according to **the Order of the Universe**.

We can say that nothing can happen, not only on earth, but anywhere in the Universe, which defies this **Order of the Universe** or is not according to it.

## 4. The Order of Creation

That portion of the Order of the Universe that pertains to earth and all the beings on earth, including human beings, we call it the Order of Creation on Earth, or simply the *Order of Creation*.
